# Clause 37 Implementation

### Winter Motorized Recreation

- 1) BC, in partnership with the signatories will develop and implement a management plan for winter motorized rec
- 2) This draft management plan will be engaged upon with technical experts, first nations, local government and snowmobile sector
- 3) Final management plan will include restrictions on access, enhancements of recreational facilities, and that the plan will be consistent with similar plans in BC

### **Status Update**

- 12 meetings from January → current
- South Peace Snowmobile Advisory Committee (local government, snowmobile sector and concerned citizens)
  - Over 300 volunteer hours invested from local snowmobile clubs, 137 from the BCSF
- Values based engagement to inform SPSAC report
  - Draft SPSAC report was provided to committee participants in Nov 2020 for review
  - Anticipated that the committee will be finalizing the document via consensus in the coming weeks
  - Values, considerations, supported management actions, and spatial recommendation based on subject matter understanding





### **Next Steps**

- SPSAC report to be finalized by participants and provided to Signatories of PA
- Commence Phase two with Signatories of PA
- Comprehensive Engagement on draft plan (spring/early summer 2021)
- Implementation of any statutory decisions in the Fall 2021






# Klinse za Park Expansion Update

- February 2020, 28,187 ha of B2 Zone established as Klinse za Park Addition
- Remainder of B2 (3,537 ha) being advanced for decision
- Zone B3
  - PA commitment for protection
  - Parties working on boundary refinement and resolution of land use issue

### Land Use Objectives

- Transitioning from modelling/analysis work to LUO development
- LUO Workplan under development:
  - Milestones, deliverables, timelines
- Considerations moving forward:
  - LUO's will have an offset component (habitat restoration) due to high disturbance levels across herd ranges
  - Minimal constraints to thlb
- Linkages:
  - Updates to the Environmental Mitigation Policy
  - Restoration planning and implementation


