Current Status & Next Steps








The draft **Boreal Caribou Protection & Recovery Plan** (BCPRP) has been developed in partnership with Fort Nelson First Nation and through collaboration with the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality.

The BCPRP will replace the existing Implementation Plan for the Ongoing Management of Boreal Caribou (Rangifer tarandus caribou pop. 14) in British Columbia released in 2011 and establishes management goals, objectives and supporting management measures for four of the five boreal caribou ranges in B.C.






Current Status

Since Engagement Closed:

- The Province, Fort Nelson First Nation and Northern Rockies Regional Municipality reviewed feedback to inform potential revisions to the draft plan and inform management recommendations.
- What We Heard report released September 2022 accessible via the engagement portal: https://engage.gov.bc.ca/caribou/boreal-caribou/.
- Post-engagement executive briefings have been completed.
- Executive engagement on decision-package on-going, seeking alignment with recent northeast First Nations' Agreements.
- Bi-lateral Contribution Agreement to support boreal caribou recovery measures with ECCC until FY 25/26 has been negotiated.




Next Steps





Ongoing Management Measures

- Predator monitoring initiated winter 2022/23 in collaboration with FNFN.
- Ongoing restoration in the Snake-Sahtahneh range led by FNFN.
- Ongoing fecal DNA, recruitment and composition surveys.
