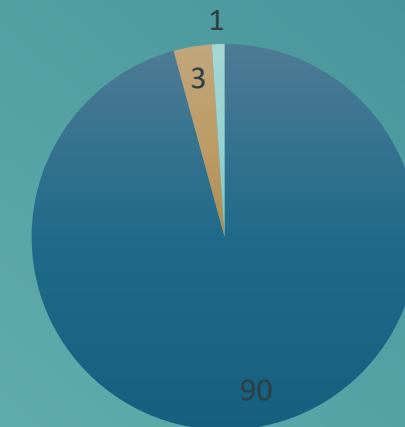
Collaborative Hunter Survey

Preliminary data summary

Introduction

- First nations' representatives and BC government staff joined 11 road checks done by COS (between September 15th and October 30th)
- In total 94 surveys collected representing 201 hunters

Residency

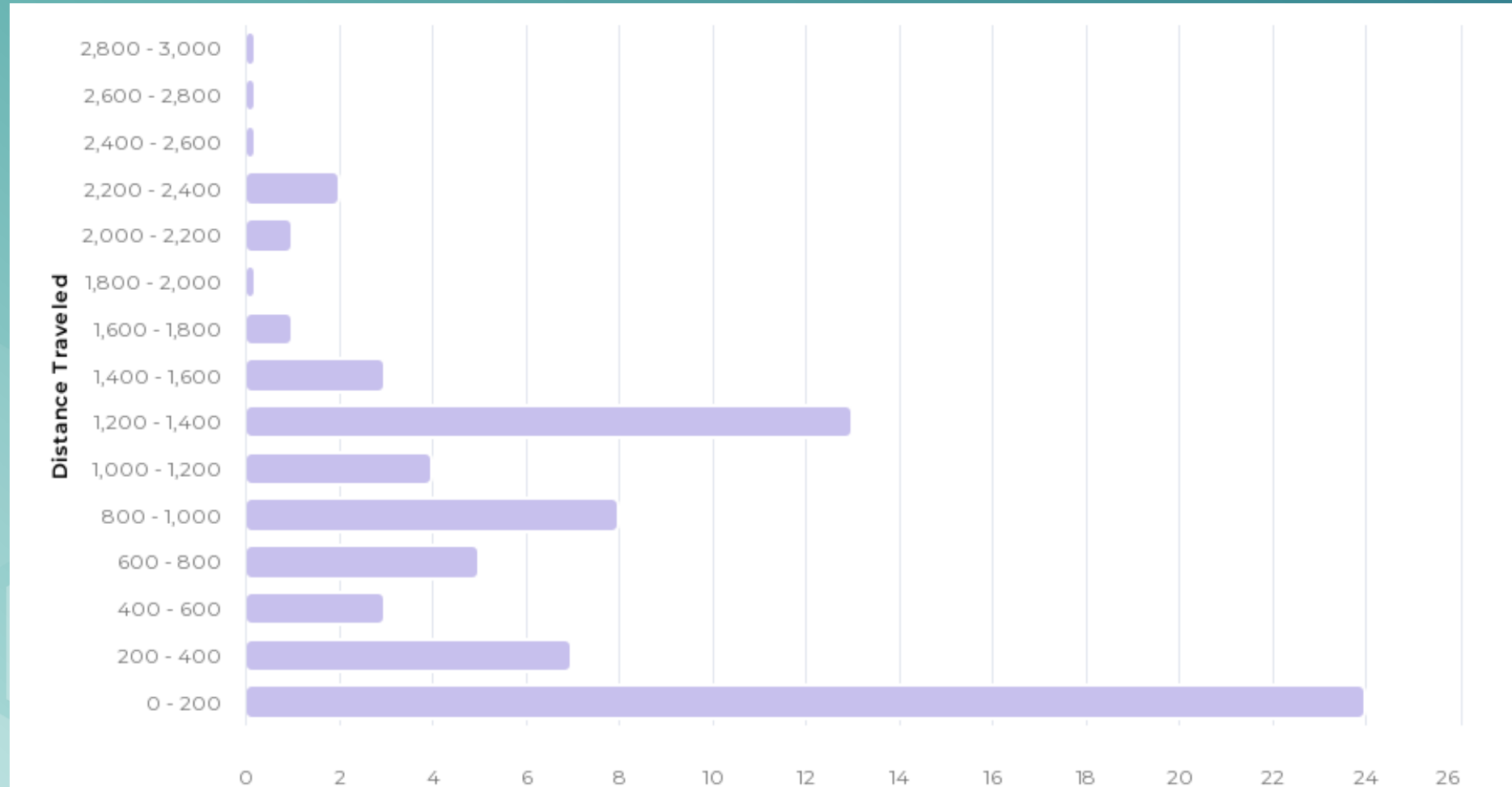

Overview

- Most used weapon was Rifle
- Most hunted specie was Elk(63 hunted, 3 harvested) and moose (47 hunted, 7 harvested)
- On average, hunters spent 7 days and 6 hours per day on their hunting trips, with an average of 2 people per group.
- Less than 30% hunted near mineral Licks
- Over 90% previously hunted in 7B
