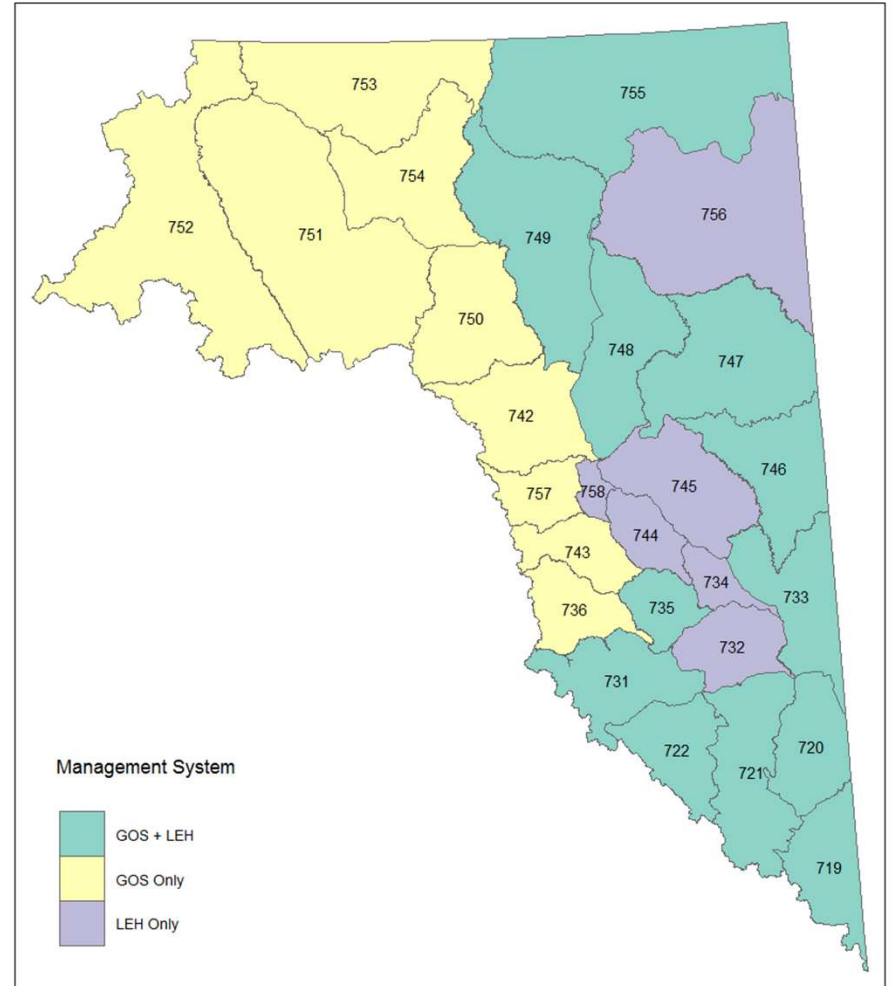

- Non-resident hunter data is taken from mandatory guide declarations

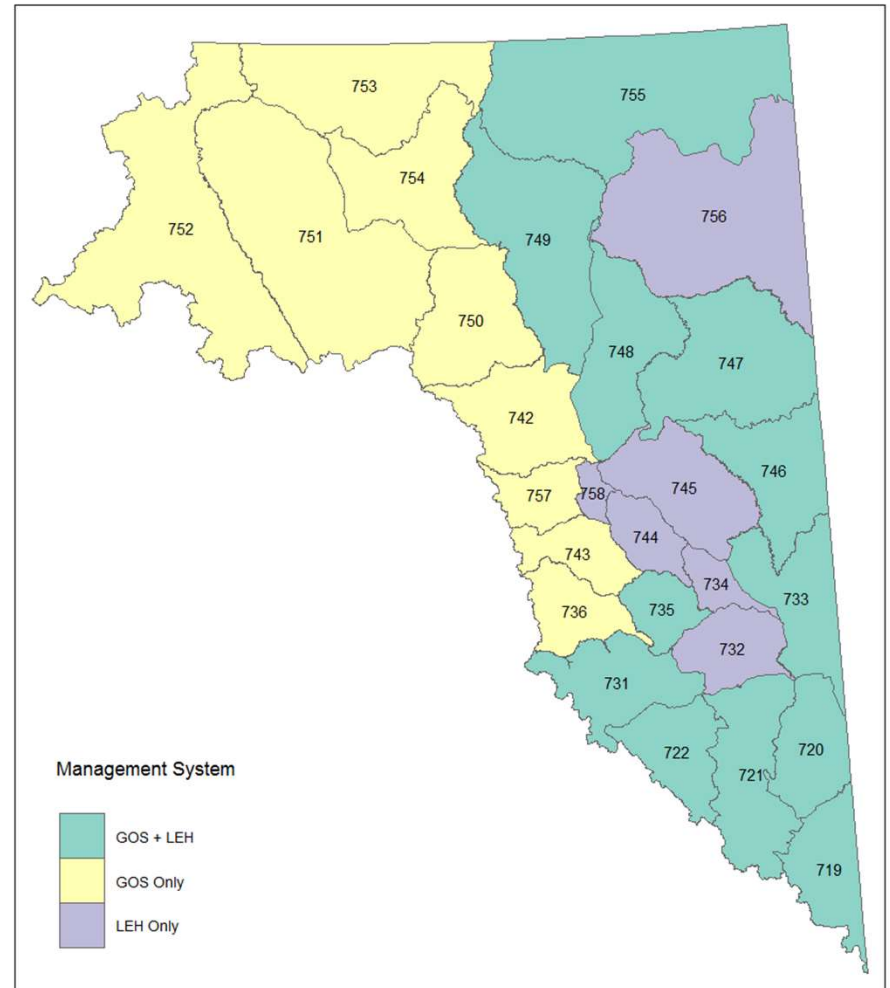

LEH Only	118	115	-	125

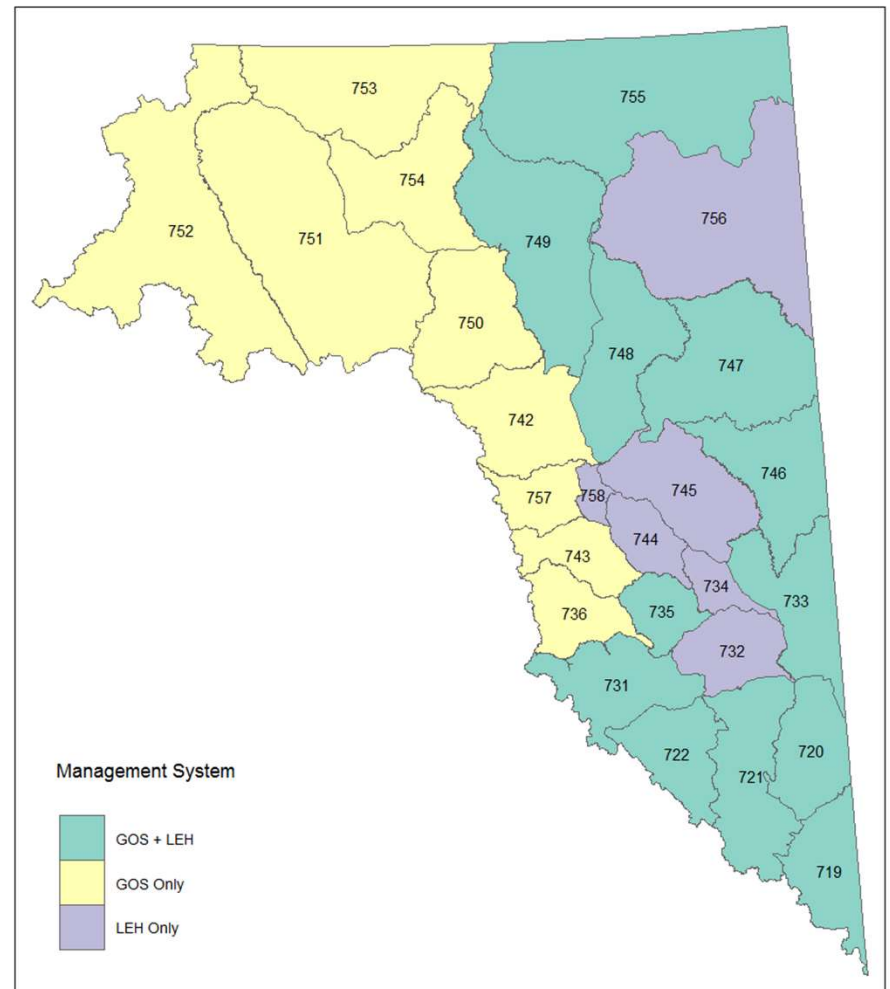

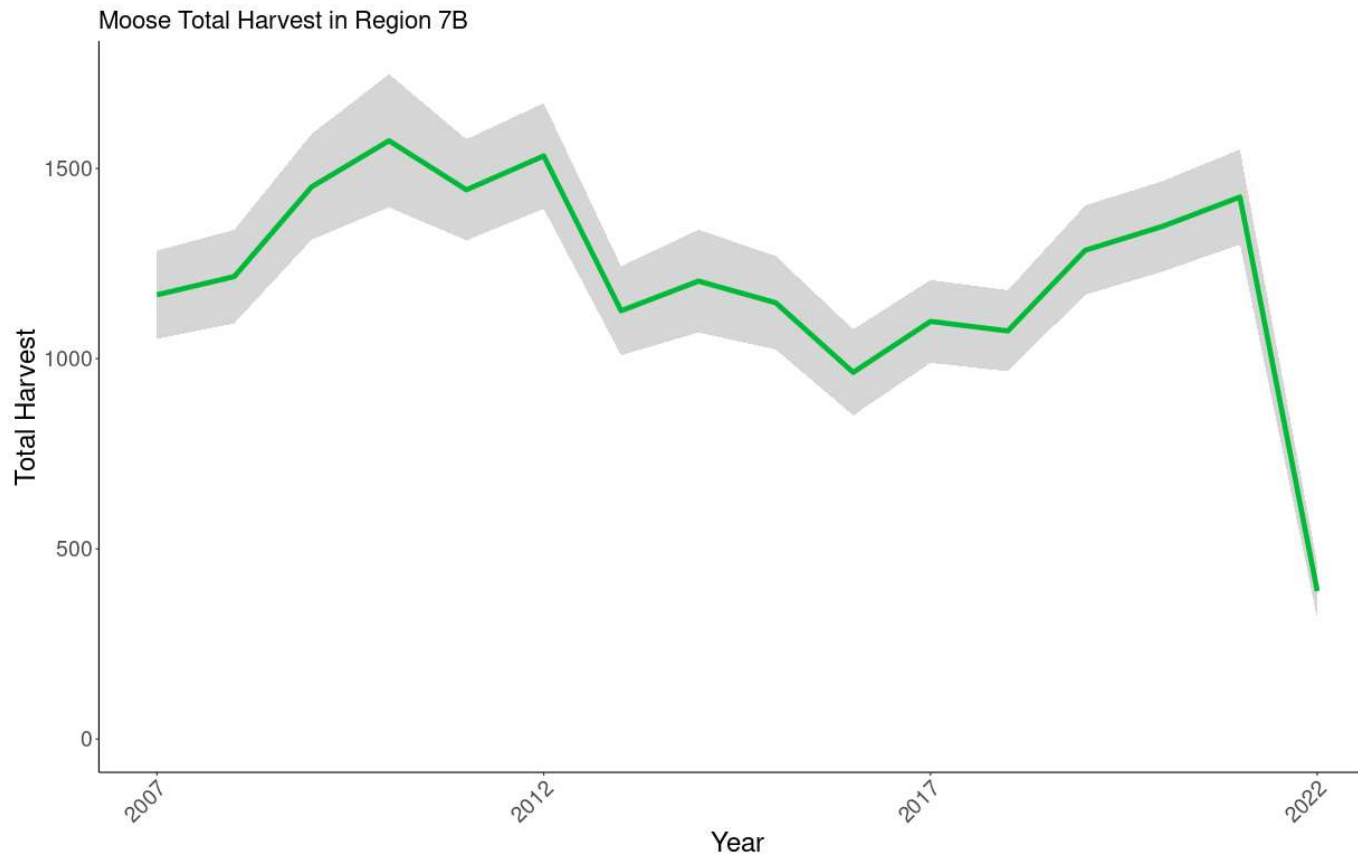

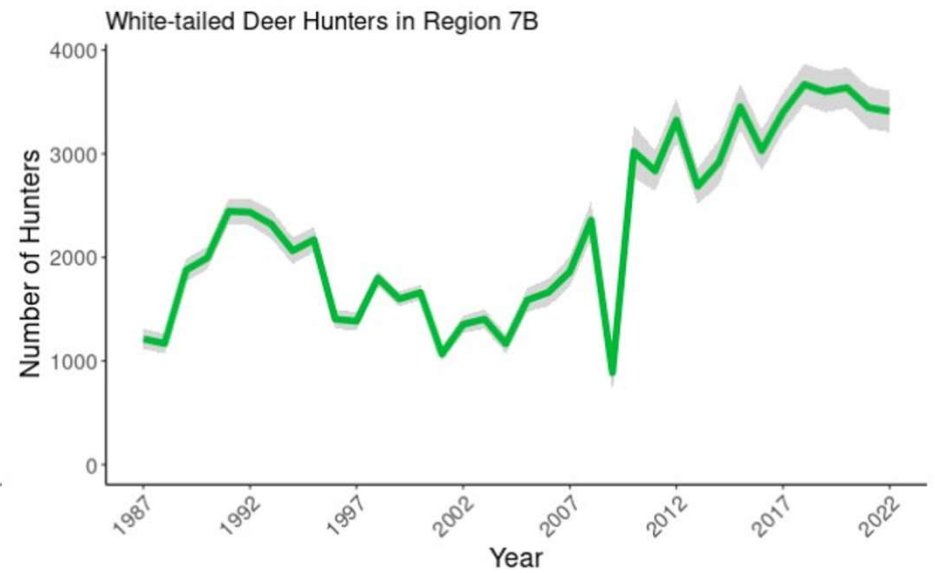
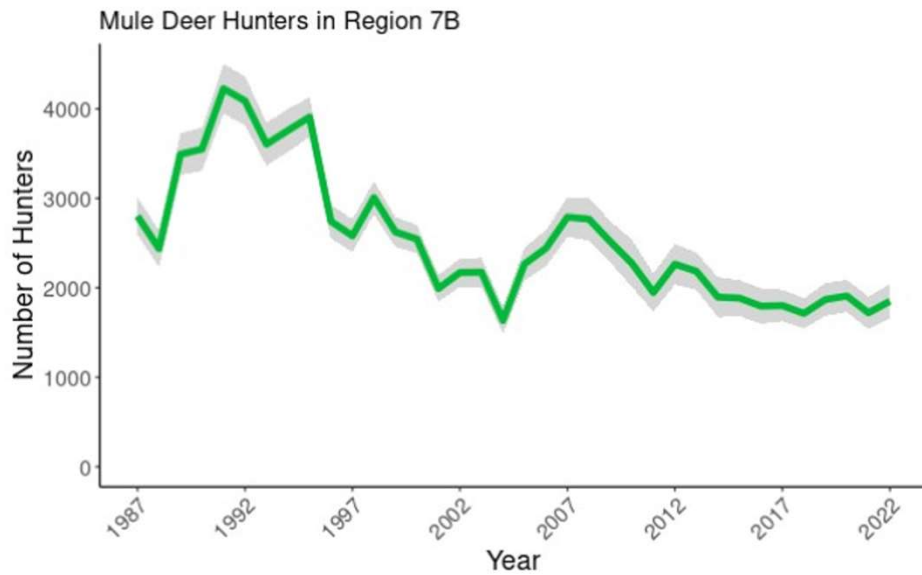


# Elk Hunters and Harvest
