




The *Boreal Caribou Protection & Recovery Plan* (BCPRP) has been developed in partnership with Fort Nelson First Nation with input from the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality. The plan underwent public engagement in 2022-23.

The BCPRP was endorsed by cabinet in Summer 2023, with direction to implement habitat protections in the most critical habitat and align other management actions with land-use planning commitments (the Liard Water and Land Stewardship Forum).




## **Forestry Context**




Interim Habitat Protections: Wildlife Habitat Areas (WHAs) Enabled by Government Action Regulation (*Forest and Range Practices Act*)

- 8 Order Units: ~2.4M ha
  - Net new protection: ~1.6M ha
- Fort Nelson TSA: ~2.3M ha
- Fort St. John TSA: ~100,000 ha
- Order language identical across units
  - Divided for administrative flexibility

## **Forestry Context**



- WHAs restrict activities under the Forest and Range Practices Act (FRPA).
- Intent of orders is No Forest Harvest or associated activities
- Habitat Restoration and Wildlife Enhancement activities are allowed
- Activities such as wildfire salvage or pest control can be granted an exemption if aligned with intent of order.
- Does not impact already issued tenures under FRPA.
- No anticipated impact to recreation access or tenure holders under other Acts due to WHA orders.
